NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Ohio Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology (Board), pursuant to Chapter 119, of the Ohio Revised Code, hereby gives notice that it will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of considering the adoption, amendment, and recession of rules.

The public hearing will be conducted on **Monday, January 31, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. at the Vern Riffe Center for Government and the Arts**, located at 77 South High Street, 31st Floor; Columbus, Ohio, 43215. The hearing will take place in the **Board Room** and continue until all parties in attendance have had an opportunity to be heard.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all individuals attending will be required to wear a mask and maintain social distancing regardless of vaccination status.

The public hearing will continue until all parties in attendance have had an opportunity to be heard. Oral or written testimony may be presented by any person affected by the proposed action.

The following rules are being proposed as amended rules:

4753-3-10 – Exempt practice; renewal.

This rule specifies the requirements for license renewal and reinstatement of an expired license. This rule is being filed under a five-year rule review with proposed changes. The proposed change corrects a reference to a statute in the rule under section (A). The reference to division (D) and (E) of section 4753.08 is being amended to reference the correct division, which is (D) of section 4753.08. Section (D) and (E) of 4753.08 were part of the former Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology. Revised Code section R.C. 4753.08 was recodified under the Ohio Speech and Hearing Professionals Board and section (E) was rescinded. The only change being proposed to rule 4753-3-10 at this time is to reference the appropriate division under Ohio Revised Code section 4753.08, e.g., division (D).

4753-7-02 – Supervision requirements; aides

This rule specifies the qualifications, training, duties, and supervision requirements for aides. This rule is being filed under a five-year rule review with proposed changes. The proposed change corrects a reference to a statute in the rule under section (E). The reference to division (M) of section 4753.10 is being amended to reference the correct division, which is (A)(13) of section 4753.10. Section (M) was part of the former Board of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology. Section (M) was recodified as section (A)(13) under the Ohio Speech and Hearing Professionals Board. The only change being proposed to rule 4753-7-02 at this time is to reference the appropriate division under Ohio Revised Code section 4753.10, e.g., division (A)(13).
